



Beginners Course Terms & Conditions

GENERAL INFORMATION

When you arrive for your session, please adhere to the following:

- Long hair should be tied back securely.
- Necklaces and dangly earrings should be removed prior to shooting.
- Loose or baggy clothing should not be worn.
- No large collars, buttons, badges, toggles, ties etc should be worn (nothing that could get caught on the bowstring).
- No excessively baggy clothes/sleeves.
- Shoes must be closed toed with full coverage over the top of the foot (no sandals or pumps etc).
- You may bring a drink with you in a resealable container.
- Smoking and vaping are not permitted while on site at either range.
- You will need to bring a pen for some sessions of the course.
- Please dress for the weather/season – archery will continue regardless of the weather.
 - Outdoors, wear thin layers, please consider sun cream, a hat, sunglasses, waterproof clothing (bearing in mind the above guidelines).
 - Indoors, Sessions are held indoors, but the hall can get cold towards the end of the sessions so we would recommend bringing something warm to pop on (bearing in mind the above guidelines).

WHAT WE WILL PROVIDE

We will provide everything else! All you need to do is bring yourself. We will provide you with all equipment, insurance, and instruction.

WHAT WE EXPECT FROM YOU & COVID/SICKNESS CONSIDERATIONS

- To complete the course, you must complete and submit a registration form including a medical declaration.
- Attend and complete every session of the course.
- Arrive on time for sessions and stay for the duration.
- Dress appropriately for archery.
- Engage appropriately and safely within the lessons.
- Not be under the influence of alcohol or drugs when you attend.

We adhere to Archery GB policies including their Code of Conduct and Rules of Shooting and uphold our beginners to the same standards.

We will follow current government guidance regarding COVID. If you are COVID positive or sick, please advise us at the earliest opportunity and we will advise you whether to attend the session or

not. If you must miss a session for any reason, then we need to know at the earliest opportunity in order for us to make accommodations and try to find a way for you to pass the course.

CANCELLATION & REFUNDS

The course will go ahead as per the planned schedule. In the unlikely event we have to reschedule a session due to unforeseeable issues every effort to communicate with you to find a suitable time/date will be made.

If you decide to cancel your place on the course, we would prefer as much notice as possible. A refund will only be issued in the event we are able to find someone else to take your place on the course. No refund will be issued in the event you do not attend the first session or make reasonable attempt in informing us of your nonattendance.

If you are unable to attend the course and wish to pass your place onto someone of your choosing their place on the course is subject to the prompt receipt of their course registration form and confirmed acceptance of them by Milton Keynes Archery Club. We reserve the right to refuse any substituted places if we do not have suitable equipment or facilities available.

If your registration form and / or medical declaration is falsified or untrue we reserve the right to remove you from the course with immediate effect if we believe you are unable to participate safely within a group coaching environment.

Your ongoing place on the course is subject to your adherence to the terms set out in this document, the course handout and policies and guidance provide by Archery GB. Failure to adhere to these could result in your expulsion from the course with no refund given.

Any serious misdemeanour will result in your immediate removal from the course and appropriate action taken.
